ORDINANCE NO. OCTOBER 11, 1995

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRANSPORTATION AND POSSESSION
OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN OPEN CONTAINERS WITHIN THE
TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of
Millcreek Township, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby
ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: TRANSPORTING OR POSSESSING ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES OR LIQUOR IN OPEN CONTAINERS IN STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES
PROHIBITED: No person shall transport or possess on his person or
in a motor vehicle any beer, wine or alcoholic beverage in an open
container in or upon the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public ways
of the Township of Millcreek, or in or upon property owned or
leased by the Township of Millcreek.

SECTION TWO: POSSESSING OR CONSUMING ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES OR LIQUOR ON PROPERTY OF ANOTHER RESTRICTED: No person
shall consume or possess beer, wine or alcoholic beverage in an
open container in or upon the property of another unless that

person is a guest, licensee or invitee of the owner or lessee of the property.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY: In the event any section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or ineffective, in whole or in part, those portions shall be deemed not to have been included and shall be severable and all other sections shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION FOUR: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION: Any person who shall violate Section One or Section Two of this Ordinance shall, for each and every such violation, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
